Key Requirements for Distinguished Talent Visa

Criterion	Summary Requirements
Professional background	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Internationally recognised record or exceptional and outstanding achievement in arts, sport, research, or academia • Still prominent in profession and active in field and achievements are internationally recognised
Employment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will have no difficulty obtaining employment or becoming established independently in Australia in a profession, arts, sport, research or academia
Nomination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominated by an Australian citizen or permanent resident, or an eligible New Zealand citizen*, OR • Nominated by an Australian organisation that has a national reputation in a relevant field of expertise and be able to verify that the applicant has an international standing
Australian community benefit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will be an asset to Australian community as a whole, economically, socially and/ or culturally
Age	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Between 18 and 55 years of age, OR • Evidence applicant would be of exceptional benefit to the Australian community
Finance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be capable of independently supporting themselves and all accompanying family members and not be financially dependent on Australian community
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have Functional English* or pay the applicable English language charge to the Department of Immigration
Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All members of the main applicant's family meet mandatory health requirements
Character and background checks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pass applicable character* checks
